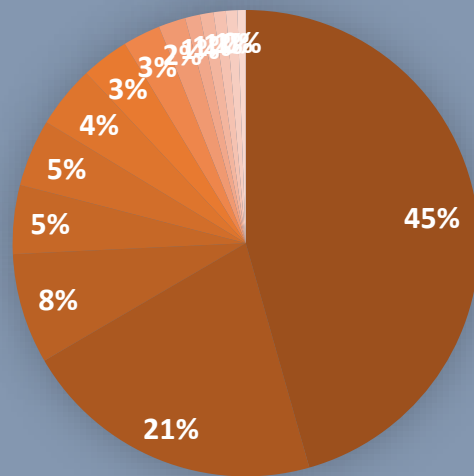

Why CEE must take a leading role in the Clean Energy Revolution?

- △ Share CEE (incl. DE) in Total EU CO2 Emissions = 51.7 %
- △ Germany and Poland
 - 66.6 % share Total CEE
 - 34.4 % share Total EU

CEE Clean Energy Platform

Energy transformation

- Focus: inclusive transition of Central European's energy sector
- Established Central European Energy Transition Taskforce, 2019
- Key energy companies from SK, CZ and HU, with regular contributions from the CEE-region
- Spin-off 2020: CEE Clean Energy Platform, endorsed by the Slovak and Croatian Presidencies

Mobility

- Batteries:
 - Slovak Battery Alliance, 2018;
 - Central European Battery value chain activity with Commissioner Sefcovic (2021)
- CEE Charging infrastructure
 - Cooperation with CEE Green Transport Initiative (SEVA+PSPA), 2021
- Slovak and Central European Autofocus, 2020+
 - How do we prepare the labor force with the new green skills?

Buildings

- High energy efficiency standards and investment priorities (RRP + MFF).
 - 50 % of Slovak's green budget of RRP is earmarked for building renovation, 2021
 - CEE building renovation activities, 2021
